


### HPL

HPL panels are high-pressure laminate boards produced by saturating multiple layers of kraft paper with phenolic resin. These panels offer high resistance to abrasion, scratches, and chemical impacts, maintaining their quality in both outdoor and indoor conditions. Available in a variety of colors and textures, HPL panels are used for surfaces, walls, and furniture in playground equipment, providing an aesthetic appearance and requiring low maintenance.



### Steel

Steel structure that is strong and durable, oven-painted galvanized and coated with lead-free polyester powder for corrosion and rust resistance. The steel meets strict EN 1176 standards, ensuring high quality and safety. The steel is anti-vandalistic, requires minimal maintenance, and is fully recyclable. The high-quality paint ensures weather resistance and maintains a new appearance over time.



## Play Panel

The play panel provides a variety of interactive play options that develop players' motor and cognitive skills. Each panel offers a unique activity that stimulates thinking and encourages players to learn and discover more.



## Toddler Slide

The toddler slide provides a safe and enjoyable sliding experience for little ones. It develops coordination, movement, balance, and self-confidence for young players.



## Climbing Wall

The climbing wall offers a physical challenge that develops the muscle strength, coordination and weight of the players. Climbing the wall improves their problem solving. This is a place where players overcome fears and develop courage and self-confidence.



## Overlays

## Moving Game

The moving game provides dynamic activity that develops players' coordination, strength, and motor skills.



## Crawl Tunnel

The Crawl Tunnel is made of ropes in natural hues that mimic tree trunks and forest branches, giving a natural and adventurous look. The bridge is elevated, enhancing the sense of adventure and challenge as players progress along a relatively narrow strip. Playing on the Crawl Tunnel encourages players to maintain balance and stability while moving, providing a fun and exciting experience reminiscent of walking through a wild forest.





## Engravings

Engravings add designs and illustrations to parts of the structure, enriching the play experience with an interesting visual element.



## Accessible Stairs

The high-durability stairs provide easy and safe access to the play structure, with a non-slip surface to prevent falls. Climbing and descending the stairs help players develop physical skills such as strength, coordination, and balance. The stairs also encourage independence and self-confidence as players learn to navigate heights and new tasks. Suitable for transfer accessibility to ensure convenient and safe access for players with disabilities, including smooth transitions from a wheelchair to the play structure and back.



### Motor Development

Foot-eye coordination - Improving coordination and balance through various equipment. Hand-eye coordination - Developing coordination and precision in activities requiring fine motor skills.



### Cognitive Development

Curiosity - Encouraging exploration and discovery through equipment providing new and unfamiliar experiences.



### Emotional Development

Imagination- Encouraging imagination and creating play worlds. Independence- Developing independence and the ability to make personal decisions. Empathy- Developing the ability to understand and accept differences and complexities.



### Social Development

Communication- Developing effective and clear communication skills with playmates. Respect for boundaries- Learning the importance of respecting personal and social boundaries.
